

### **Walking Tour: Jewish Sights and Places (Duration: 2 hours)**

This walking tour will take through two old Berlin districts well known as the Barn District and the Spandauer Suburbia (Spandauer Vorstadt).  
This tour can be of course also made by vehicle.

- Memorial to the Women's Protest
- Former Jewish Quarter and streets
- Hackesche Höfe – Germany's largest backyards ensemble
- Oldest Jewish Cemetery with tomb of Moses Mendelssohn
- Old Jewish Boys School
- Broom and Brush factory of Otto Weidt
- Memorial to the November Pogrom (The abandoned Room)
- New Synagogue on Oranienburger Street (built in 1866)

### **Additional places to be visited by vehicle or urban transports only:**

- Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe
- Jewish Museum by Daniel Libeskind
- Track 17 - Memorial to the deported and expelled Jewish Citizens
- Jewish Community Centre of West-Berlin
- Rykestrasse Synagogue
- Quarter of "Bayerisches Viertel" – Art exhibition to the social marginalization of Jewish Citizens
- Exhibition "Topography of Terror" former area of the central offices of the Nazi regime
- The Wannsee Conference Memorial
